Fluency Tutors Needed!

Are you interested in helping students with their reading or math?

D65 Everybody Reads Fluency Program

What is Everybody Reads? This District 65 program trains volunteers in a specific tutoring technique that provides support to classroom teachers. Children who read fluently are better able to understand and retain the information they read.

How and When Can I Help? As a trained volunteer, you support one elementary school teacher (2nd -5th grade) and 2-4 students (one-on-one tutoring) throughout the school year. Tutors volunteer at all 12 elementary and magnet schools.

D65 Math is FUNDamental Fluency Program

What is Math is FUNDamental? This District 65 math tutoring program was created to provide support to targeted District 65 students in 1st grade. The goal is to increase fluency of fundamental, age-appropriate math facts that could help increase students' growth in mathematical achievement.

How and When Can I Help? As a trained volunteer, you support one elementary school teacher (1st grade) by meeting with a small group of students (2-4 students) 1-2 times per week for 30 minutes throughout the school year. Tutors volunteer at all 12 elementary and magnet schools.

Tutoring for both programs occurs during school hours (9am-3:35pm). Tutors volunteer once or twice per week for approximately one hour each visit from October through May. Spanish fluency tutors are also needed. Training sessions are provided prior to the first tutoring session.
