We are excited to host our first service projects of the year! We will be doing two during the month of October.

Bernie's Book Bank: This year the book collection is a competition! The class that donates the most books will receive tickets to a Northwestern Basketball game. We would like the cooperation of each grade level to have a bin in one teacher's classroom to collect the books. The service committee will provide labels for EVERY classroom to account for the books that are donated per classroom. At the end of the drive, we will tally all books that are donated per class. The winning class will be announced at the end of the drive. We will place 1 bin in the following classrooms: Kindergarten - Mullins, First Grade - Bardic, Second Grade - Maldonado, Third Grade - Arceneuax, Fourth Grade - Rouse, Fifth Grade - Panagiotidis, and the Library - Hertel

The Sports Shed: We are partnering with The Sports Shed to collect new and gently used sports equipment. This year, The Sports Shed is celebrating it's 10th anniversary of getting kids off the streets and into sports. They have partnered with 200 organizations and impacted thousands of kids in under resourced communities.
