Check Lost & Found: Dec 15th & 16th

District 65 Updates/Info

- Shield Testing: Given the low interest and turnout, we are canceling SHIELD testing at JEH on
 Tuesday mornings. The last day of testing was Tuesday, November 29th. We will still participate
 in Outbreak Testing, meaning if there is an outbreak at your school declared by the health
 department (3 or more confirmed connected cases in the same cohort/class), we can have
 SHIELD come to your school for testing. We will continue to provide home tests to
 families/students/staff who are exposed and need them to the extent they are available.
 Depending on interest, we may also host a community testing event prior to winter break.
- Registration for 6th Grade: All current 5th-grade students must complete a required registration to enter middle school. The process includes an online registration to validate or correct all contact information, next year's school info, and residency verification. The Registration Office will send detailed information directly to families after winter break.
- E-Learning Days: District 65 has an approved E-Learning Plan. If school buildings are unexpectedly closed, the District may choose to enact an E-Learning Day rather than cancel the instructional day. This means that schools will be closed and staff and students will engage in remote teaching and learning. These days do not need to be made up at the end of the school year.
